



How to enter cases at MedU, once you have your password.

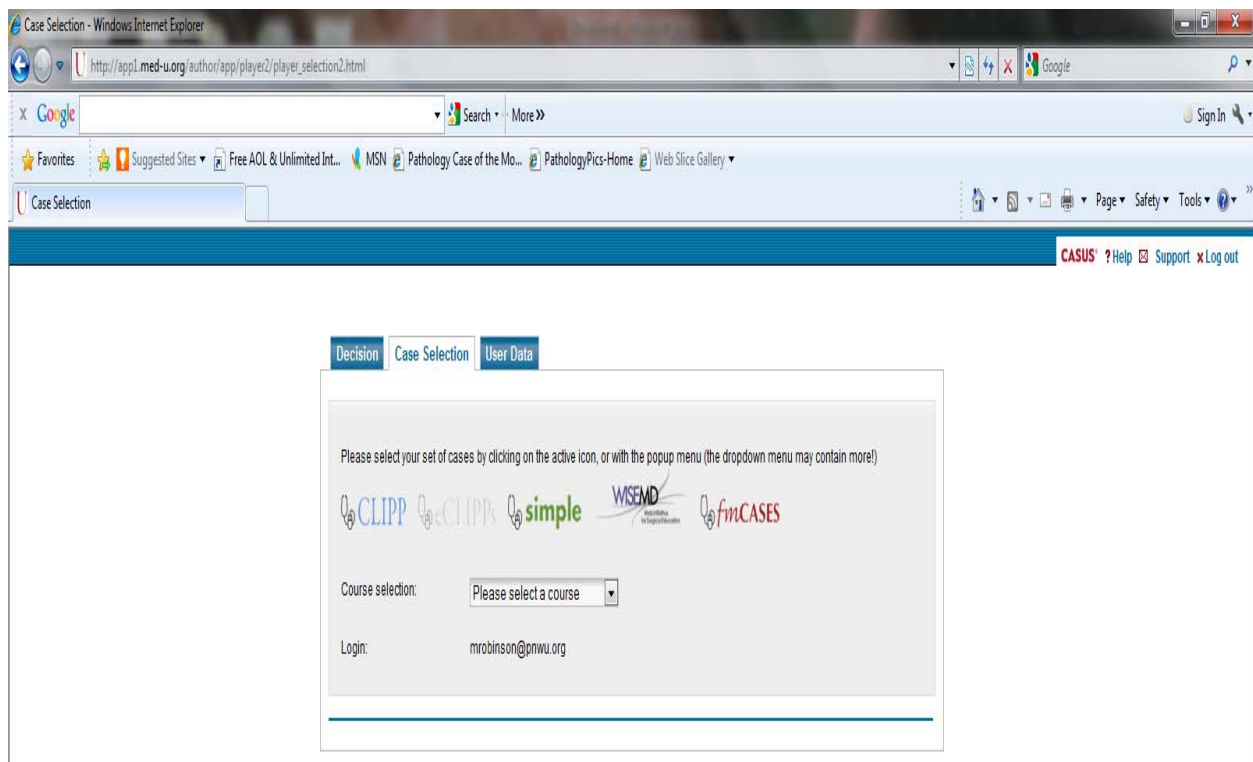

Case Selection – **Click on this tab** to access the case selection page

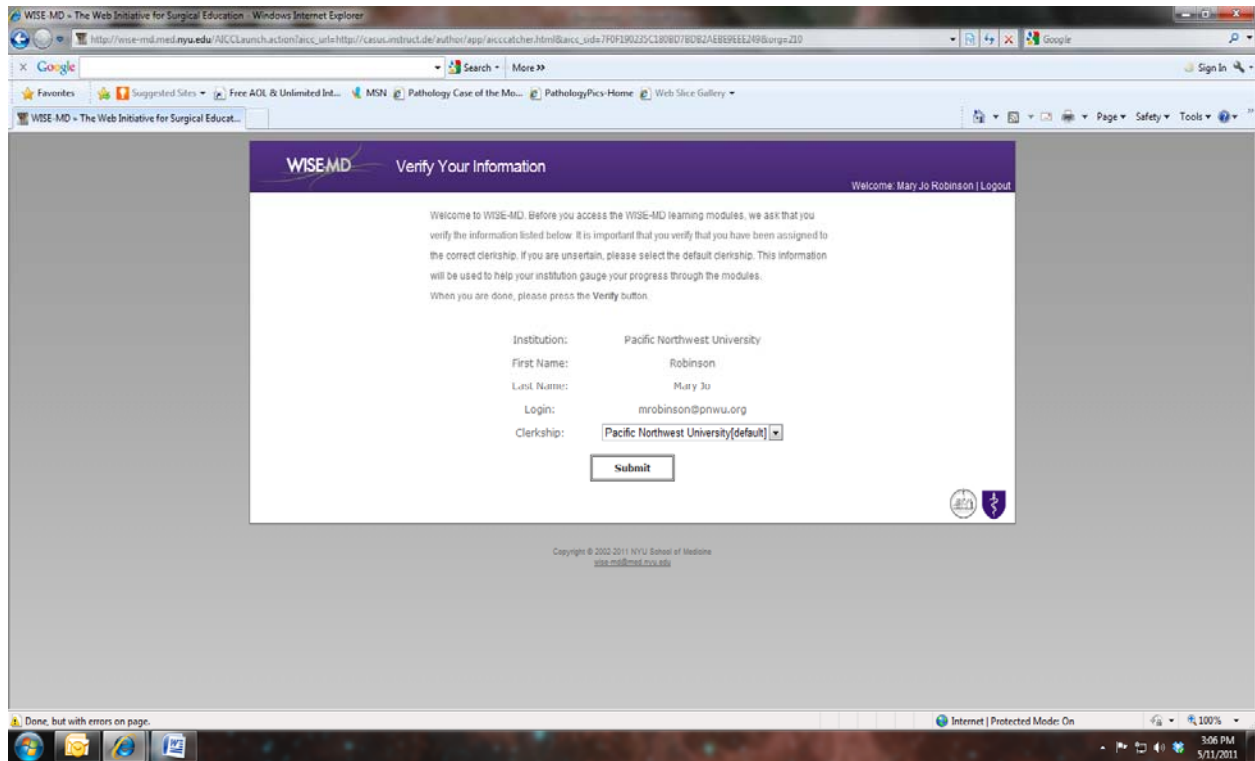
User Data- ONLY to be used if you need to change your password!

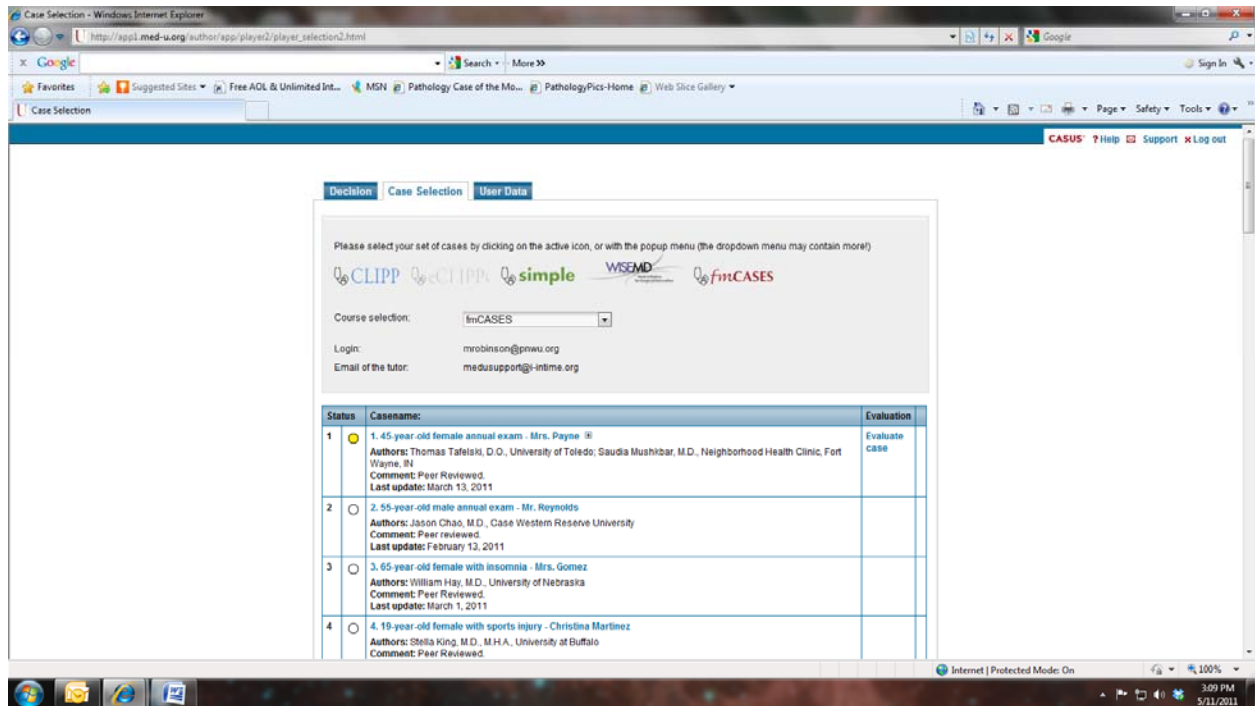


Depending on your rotation you will get a listing of cases or a page asking you to verify your rotation
